Rifle Specification/Classes: Note: For full rifle spec rules, refer to website for detailed rules.

<u>Spec 1</u>: Service Vintage - Standard - Any issued iron sights service rifle in original as-issued condition. <u>Sub-Spec 1a</u>: Commonwealth Issue Service – Sub Spec of 1.

Spec 2: Service/Sporter - Modified Service or Sporter fixed-adjustable rifles with Iron sights.

<u>Spec 3</u>: Open - Match Iron - Any commercial, sporter, factory, service or custom, any calibre, iron sights.

<u>Spec 5</u>: Open - Optical sights - As per any above Spec's but fitted with optical sights.

Sub-Spec 5a: Hunter/Sporter: - Optical sights – limited to factory lite rifles, max 9x scope.

IMC & TMC GRAND PRIX SERIES (GP) DETAILS

There are many sanctioned matches and 2x GP Championships for 2011. Each GP aggregate is based on your <u>best</u> 3 IMC or <u>best</u> 3 TMC results from any of the Grand Prix rounds sanctioned by AIHPA (as listed below). The series aggregate works on the basis that each shooter can attend as many meets possible, but only the best 3 results are used and all the rest are dropped.

Note: The IMC series runs for all rifle specs - shooters may contest more than 1 spec. The TMC is Open spec.

AIHPA COURSES OF FIRE

International Match Course

The International Match Course is the course shot at many major shooting tournaments and championships around the world. This is a 50 round match, including 2 sighters before each 4 strings, totalling 58 rounds. 80 shot matches have a doubling of the standing, sitting and prone rapid strings.

Vintage (Service) Match Course

This course was created for Vintage (spec 1) bolt action rifles. VMC event allows any rifle spec to compete, however event programs should be consulted for specific details.

Tactical Match Course

This course is an open spec course, meaning any rifle can compete, and all compete together. The use of a front rest or bi-pod is permitted, however no rear rest is allowed.

Australian (Service) Match Course

This course is slightly modified from one of the Commonwealths oldest courses of fire shot by services for training and marksmanship classification. It has been slightly modified to suit currently Australian legal firearms, however the fundamentals remain unchanged.
